

BB PRINT STADIUM CONDITION OF ENTRY

- For contact tracing purposes, BB Print Stadium is using the [Check In Qld](#) app and encourages you to download the app prior to attending the Stadium if you haven't done so already. We recommend adding your details and those of your guests before arriving at BB Print Stadium. You can add extra guest details through the 'Frequent Guests' section accessed by the menu at the top left corner of the app. When you arrive at BB Print Stadium, all you'll be required to do is scan the QR code and show staff / security that you've checked in.
- The wellbeing of all patrons, players and staff is our priority.
- Covid Safe Conditions of entry:

IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO YOU OR ANY MEMBER OF YOUR BOOKING PARTY, YOU OR THEY MUST NOT COME TO BB PRINT STADIUM:

- Required to self-isolate under laws aimed at reducing the spread of COVID-19
- Diagnosed as having COVID-19
- You have experienced symptoms including fever, cough, sore throat, fatigue, shortness of breath, runny nose, or loss of taste or smell in the last 14 days
- You or a member of your household has been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- You or a member of your household has been in close contact with anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms
- You or a member of your household has travelled overseas in the past 14 days
- You or a member of your household has travelled to a COVID-19 hotspot in Australia in the past 14 days
- If these apply to you or any member of your booking party, please contact MECC Box Office to arrange a refund for that ticket. You can contact MECC Box Office on 49619777 Monday to Friday, 9am to 4.30pm, Saturday 10am to 1pm.

Things we need you to do:

It is a condition of entry that all patrons provide contact tracing details. To save time, download the Check In Qld app prior to your next visit and add your details as well as those of your guests. On arrival, you can scan our unique QR code upon entry. You will then need to show staff your completed check in on entry

- Under the Queensland Public Health Order, masks must be worn at ALL stadiums in Queensland, and can only be removed to eat or drink.
- Observe physical distancing where possible in all areas of the venue
- If you're unwell, stay home and contact the MECC Box Office Team 0749619777 to arrange a refund if you cannot attend because you're unwell.
- The right of admission is reserved. BB Print Stadium Management reserve the right to refuse entry to, or to remove from, the Stadium any Patrons who are drunk or disorderly or whose conduct is unlawful or offensive or who are not entitled to attend the Event. Any person who causes a disturbance or who refuses to comply with reasonable requests from the Manager and security may be removed from the Stadium.
- Patrons under the age of 12 must always be under the direct supervision of an adult. BB Print Stadium Management, reserve the right to refuse entry to, or to remove from, the Stadium or to refer to the police any Patron under the age of 12 who are without adult supervision.

- Patrons are prohibited from entering the Stadium's areas designated as not being accessible by the public.
- Patrons may be denied entry if they have not complied with the relevant directions of the Queensland Government Chief Health Officer.
- Patrons must not wear or display commercial, political, religious, or offensive signage or logos, sell any goods or services or give away political, religious, advertising, or promotional materials without the prior written approval of BB Print Stadium Management.
- Patrons who are, in the opinion of BB Print Stadium Management, offensively attired or whose attire may cause a hazard or compromise safety may be refused entry into the Stadium.
- Bags and other items will be subject to inspection and Patrons may be searched. Patrons who refuse inspections or searches may be denied entry to the Stadium.
- Bags permitted into the venue must meet the following conditions:
 - > Maximum bag height – 40 cm
 - > Maximum bag width – 40 cm
 - > Maximum bag depth – 40 cm
 - > Pliable nature (soft to touch)
- Pass-outs may be issued at the discretion of security.
- Alcoholic beverages must not be taken into or out of the Event. It is an offence for minors to purchase or consume alcohol or for Patrons to supply alcohol to minors.
- Patrons are not permitted to enter the venue with commercially packaged food or beverage. Patrons will be advised to dispose of such items or will have the items confiscated prior to entering BB Print Stadium. Patrons are permitted to enter the venue with homemade food, sealed water bottle (up to 1.25L) and sealed juice in small cardboard containers (up to 250ml). This does not apply to food or beverages for patrons with special dietary requirements, provided that such food or beverage are not packaged in prohibited containers.
- Deliveries from external caterers will not be permitted into the Stadium.
- Items which, in the opinion of BB Print Stadium Management & security, have the potential to cause injury or a nuisance or inconvenience to any other person will not be permitted into the Stadium. These include controlled, dangerous, or illegal substances, seating, bottles, flares, fireworks, laser pointers, loud hailers and weapons of any description and may include certain musical instruments, flags and flagpoles and any other items considered by the Manager to have the potential to cause injury or a nuisance or inconvenience to any other person.
- Unless approved by BB Print Stadium Management. Patrons are not permitted to transmit, broadcast, sell, license, or otherwise publish, disseminate, or reproduce any recordings (including photographic, video or sound recordings) of the Event. Such recordings may be confiscated or erased. Any recordings or recording device which are confiscated will become the property of BB Print Stadium Management.
- Patrons acknowledge that the Stadium owner, Manager, or the Hirer may use a person's image or likeness as part of any recording of the Event.
- Umbrellas are not permitted in the event.
- Chairs are not permitted in the event.
- Prams & Strollers may not obstruct viewing or pathways and placement is at the discretion of the BB Print Management Staff.

- Flags & Banners – BB Print Stadium management acknowledges that banners and flags are part of the atmosphere that is created as part of the events held at BB Print Stadium. Given this fact, the venue permits flags and banners to be brought into the venue and waved during appropriate times during the event. Banners are permitted and can be used inside the venue under the following conditions:
 - The flagpole must be no greater than 1.5m in length and 2cm in diameter
 - The banner has no language on it that could be deemed offensive to other patrons or players. (Items include offensive, racial, sexual, political, and personal statement. Conflicting hirer or venue sponsor banners are also deemed to be unacceptable).
 - The banner must not hinder other patron’s enjoyment of the event through obstruction of their view of the field of play or video replay screen.
 - The banner cannot cover any existing venue advertising or directional signage.
- Patrons assume all risk of any damage or loss (including property damage, personal injury, economic and consequential loss) however it arises at the event. Patrons bring personal effects onto the premises at their own risk. BB Print Stadium Management will not be responsible for any damage to or loss or theft of a person's personal property.
- Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the Stadium and its precincts and
 - within 5 metres of any public transport waiting point outside the Stadium (including taxi and limousine ranks and areas outside of the 5-metre zone where the person smoking is standing in a queue which starts within the 5-metre zone).
- Patrons who smoke in any of the above areas, do not comply with any COVID-19 health direction, or who fail to obey a direction from the Manager or another authorised person to cease smoking or comply with a health direction in the Stadium or its precincts:
 - may commit an offence against the *Tobacco and Other Smoking Products Act 1998 (Qld)* or the *Public Health Act 2005 (Qld)*, to which fines apply; and
 - may be immediately evicted from the Stadium.
- Patrons acknowledge and accept that these Terms of Entry may be amended at any time.
